

Thank you for taking the time to pray about how and where God can use you as a volunteer at Eastpoint and The Point, our new community center. Volunteering is a great way to get involved in our community and a wonderful opportunity to spread the love of Jesus to those around us. God has wired us uniquely to serve His church. Here are some great opportunities for serving at Eastpoint and The Point!

Eastpoint

Big Events - Throughout the year we host special events where our whole church comes together to celebrate. For these events, we need all hands on deck! This is a great opportunity to begin volunteering at Eastpoint. Stay tuned for specific event related forms on our website.

First Impressions - This ministry is responsible for creating a warm and friendly environment at Eastpoint. Our parking lot attendants, greeters, welcome kiosk attendants, and café hosts all work together to welcome our guests. **First Impressions Volunteers are on an "every-other-month" rotation.*

Information Kiosk: If you are a people person and love Eastpoint, this is a great role for you. Volunteers at the Information Kiosk are trained to give people information so they can connect with groups, classes, ministries, and outreach activities. Volunteers serve before and after each service.

Café: Cafe workers are trained to make coffee, tea, and cocoa and serve it with a smile and a pleasant greeting. Volunteers are on duty 45 minutes before service.

Door Greeter: If you have a bright smile and helpful spirit, this is the role for you! Door greeters simply open the doors and welcome people as they enter the building. They may be needed to assist with strollers or wheelchairs. Volunteers serve before and after each service.

Program Distributor: These volunteers cheerfully hand out programs as people enter the auditorium. Volunteers serve before each service.

Roadie: These individuals help people arrive safely and swiftly to a parking place. If you look good in safety green, like waving wands, and talking on a two-way radio, this is the volunteer role for you! Volunteers serve before, during, and after each service but will be able to attend one service.

Guides: Guides help accompany and direct newcomers to places inside the building. Volunteers are equipped with maps to help people find classrooms, restrooms, children's

ministry, and other spots within our expansive facility. Guides serve before and after each service.

Ushers: These volunteers serve inside of the auditorium and help people find a place to sit. They also take up offering and distribute communion. Volunteers serve before, during, and after each service.

Communion Prep and Cleanup: These volunteers load communion trays with bread and juice and place them in the auditorium. Volunteers serve before and after each service.

Discover Eastpoint Team: If you love meeting new people and have the gift of hospitality, this is the role for you! These volunteers set up food and supplies for the Discover Eastpoint Event that happens twice a month. They also help answer questions and share about their experiences at Eastpoint.

Tech Team - Serving on the Tech Team provides an opportunity to use your gifts and talents to help the Sunday service run smoothly. There are also opportunities to work in children, student, and young adults ministries on Sunday's and for special events.

Producer: Leads the entire Tech Team in calling out cues and is the "go to" person regarding the flow of the service. Ultimately responsible for the look and feel of the service. Located in the Control Room.

FOH Engineer: Operates the FOH audio console and mixes the audio that the audience hears. Located in the FOH booth.

A2: Assists and calls out cues for the FOH Engineer. (Can train to be the FOH Engineer.)

Monitor Engineer: Operates the monitor audio console and mixes the audio that the worship team hears in their monitors on stage, located on stage left.

Stage Manager: Coordinates the movement of people and equipment backstage, and assists the Monitor Engineer and Worship Team. (Can train to be the Monitor Engineer.)

Video Director: Directs all camera shots and angles, switching of cameras, and computer graphics. Determines what goes on the screens. Located in the Control Room.

Video Switcher: Executes the Video Director's commands on the video switcher, cutting between cameras and computers that display on the screens. Located in the Control Room. (Can train to be the Video Director.)

FOH Cameras 1 & 2: Operates the cameras on tripods in the FOH Booth, adjusting camera shots and angles according to the Video Director.

Stage Camera: Operates the handheld camera on or in front of the stage, getting close-up shots of the Worship Team. Adjusts camera shots and angles according to the Video Director.

CG: Operates a computer to display lyrics, graphics, slides and videos on the screens, as directed by the Video Director. Located in the Control Room.

Lighting: Operates the lighting console to light both the stage and auditorium, by recording and playing back lighting “cues.” Located in the FOH Booth.

Children's Ministry - This ministry shares the love of Jesus with the youngest members of our church family. Whether you enjoy teaching kids, caring for infants, or helping out with administration, this is a great place to make a difference in the lives of Eastpoint families.

Nursery: Volunteers in this position help to provide parents comfort in knowing that their babies will be snuggled, changed, and cared for in a loving manner.

Preschool: Volunteers in this role help provide the class a basic knowledge of who God is and our volunteers help show God’s love through their words and actions.

Elementary: For our Elementary students, we need a variety of volunteers on a Sunday morning.

Check-in: Welcoming families, answer basic questions, help families get their kids where they need to go.

Small Group Leaders: lead 5-8 kids in activities and discussions for part of the morning.

Large Group Leaders: lead a larger group of kids through an interactive skit which will help kids with the lesson of the week.

Prep: preparing the lesson for the upcoming Sunday.

Worship Leader: helping the kids sing our two songs each Sunday.

Playscape Monitor: Our playscape will be open on Sunday for all the kids whose parents are serving. We need people to watch these kids and maybe even play a few games with them!

Student Ministry - Student Ministry is designed to help middle school and high school students know Jesus, apply His teachings, and live out His mission. If you love spending time with teens, staying up late, or playing goofy games, this is the ministry for you.

Youth Leaders: This is a great way to interact one on one with students! You would lead a small group of students and discuss questions that go along with the evening's message, play games, and help lead events and trips.

Sunday Night Host: A Sunday night host is essential for someone who is new, you will lead them through the building and help them get involved and plugged into a small group.

Confusion: This is a child care service that we offer for the youth leaders' children, this is such a blessing to our leaders so that the parent(s) may lead and not have to worry about the kids while they are with their small group.

Parent ministry: If you want to help keep parents in the loop and also host some parent seminars and teachings then this would be a great way to serve.

Food: As you can imagine, teenagers can eat a lot of food. We offer food for our Sunday night meetings and everyday after school for our study/homework room in the youth room. If you would commit to a specific day or night to provide food/snacks, it would be a huge blessing.

Prayer: Prayer is everything. We would love to have you join our prayer ministry, by meeting regularly and praying for each of our students as they face some of the toughest and challenging times in their lives.

Events: Are you good at planning and running events? Then we would love to have you join us as we go on adventures with our students throughout the year.

Admin: Youth admins help with data entry, planning and confirming trips and events, keeping up on all of the needs of the ministry and assist the youth pastors and leaders to create an environment to allow them to have time to meet with students and other leaders.

Young Adults Ministry - If you love connecting with college students, young professionals, or young marrieds, consider joining our Young Adults Ministry Team. From leading a Life Group to mentoring or helping with events, we have plenty of opportunities for you to plug in.

Worship Team: Be part of the team who leads our Young Adults in worship. *Auditions will be required for this role. Someone from our Worship Team will be in touch with you regarding an audition time.

Connections: Welcome and connect with new young adults as they join us at our events.

Photographer/Videographer: Help capture moments when we are gathered together at our events.

Set Up/Tear Down: Help set up before our events as well as tear down after our events.

The Point

Our new community center, The Point, will be open 6 days a week to the public for a variety of classes, events, and programs. Volunteer positions will be scheduled in shifts throughout the day. We encourage volunteers from Eastpoint as well as volunteers from the public to sign up!

Host/Hostess: Do you enjoy engaging with people and being a resource? In this new position, you will greet people and help direct internal traffic, give tours, notice new faces and connect, straightening things up all while floating and always find the answer!

Coffee Bar: Do you love coffee and people? In this role, you will be serving coffee with a smile and engaging with people. Volunteers will make coffee as well as basic cleaning and stocking of the coffee bar area.

Room Setup and Break-down: Groups will be using The Point in a variety of different ways throughout the week. This position will help prepare rooms by moving tables and chairs as needed, and make sure all supplies are available as requested, etc.

Playscape Monitor: In this role you will be able to use your natural ability to interact with children and parents as you help them check-in and check-out of the Playscape.

General Volunteer Positions for both Eastpoint and The Point:

Maintenance: Are you handy? Put your skills to use by helping with general maintenance and special projects. Maybe it's washing windows or building a stage set. It could be

sanitizing the soccer field or touching up paint. As we move into the new facility there will be many opportunities to put your skills to work.

Administrative Support: Do you have administrative talents? We could use your help in a variety of different ways. It might be answering the phones, stuffing envelopes, entering data, helping with scheduling, or a multitude of other tasks.

Safety Team: We don't expect crises to occur, but when they do, we want to be ready! As a member of the safety team you could be called on to be "Eyes on the Ground" just watching for things that seem to be out of place, asked to find an ice pack or band aide for someone with a cut or bruise, spread some sand on a slippery sidewalk, or help defuse a conversation that may be getting a bit out of control.
